

The first issue of the year provides a brief recap of equities and options trading at WEX, in addition to information on new services and WEX Trading Platform (WTP) enhancements implemented in the last year.

WEX OPTIONS ELECTRONIC VOLUME AND FILL RATES RISE



WEX daily average options electronic volume was up over 57% in 2013, approximately 55% more than the industry average of 1.9% (based on OCC volume). WEX continues to focus on providing industry-leading fill rates. With new exchanges coming online and escalating market fragmentation, it has become increasingly complex to access displayed liquidity. This is largely due

to differing performance at exchanges and continued speed improvements by market makers. With a knowledgeable router team, WEX made a series of enhancements late last year to further improve our option fill rates.



WEX EQUITY VOLUME RISES



WEX equity average daily volume was up over 13% in 2013, even as the industry average daily volume dropped. This increase was largely driven by the growth of WEX Best X, an arrival price algorithm that consistently outperformed other arrival price algorithms every month throughout the year (results based on WEX Wheel SM data for a large proprietary trading

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2013 HIGHLIGHTS FOR WTP

Help! I tried to cancel one order in WTP but the confirmation is telling me I am about to cancel all orders. What do I do?

Hit the Esc key on your key board. The "cancel all " confirmation you see means you have all your orders selected and hitting escape will deselect all orders.

WEX Client Portal (WCP): Execution and Order History

Use WCP to view your execution or order history for the last 60 days.
Reports can be run by portfolio, security type, routes, users, and other parameters that you can easily enter. WCP is available to all WTP users.

Managed Orders

- Eye feature added in Vol Trader enables the "Work Bid or Offer" option to place an IOC (Immediate or Cancel) order to buy at the ask or sell at the bid (Jan)
- Additional notifications added for Staged Executions (Aug)
- Ability to restore deleted Managed Orders (Aug)
- New Managed Order applet, Hedge Agent, introduced. See Hedge Agent description (Oct)

Market Data

- Corporate Action Viewer: View corporate actions, corporate events, delisted symbols, dividends, IPOs, splits, and symbol changes (Jan)
- Symbol Browser: Search for securities by name or symbol (Jan)
- Most Active Symbols Viewer: View most active symbols by value, volume, and percentage change (Jan)



Spreads

- Spread Agent safeguard, enabling hedging with BASB limit orders added (May)
- BOX Spreads supported (Jun)
- Ability to view Average Leg Price Across Multiple Spreads (Jul)
- Montreal spread data supported (Sep)
- Report Trade Spread Ticket (Sep)

Staged Orders

 Launch Basket Trader or Spread Trader when multiple Staged Orders are released for execution (May)

Industry & Market Structure

- Limit Up/Limit Down functionality added (April)
- Mini Options supported (Jan)
- Jumbo Options supported (Jun)
- ISE Gemini Exchange launch (Jul)

Hedge Agent

- Automatically hedge executed options positions (Oct)
 - Calculate hedge quantities based on the current delta.
 - Immediately send out the corresponding hedge order after an option order is executed
 - Delta hedge an entire portfolio



Canadian Trading

- Ability to trade Canadian equities, options, spreads, and futures in WTP
- Ability to receive market data from Toronto and Montreal

Crossing

- The WEX Hammer allows a user to sweep the market up to a defined limit price and cross the remaining balance (Oct)
 - Sweeps multiple levels of liquidity from all available exchanges while sourcing unpublished liquidity at the client's ultimate price



Algorithms

- WEX VWAP: Works orders using Best X's proprietary execution logic to execute trades along a historical volume distribution within a specified time period.
- WEX Basket VWAP: Designed to work with long/short equity or market neutral baskets, the WEX Basket VWAP manages executions for basket or index components using Best X logic and historical volume distributions. When executing long/short baskets, this approach strives to keep the basket neutral throughout the execution.

General Improvements

- Short Sale Restricted securities are flagged in yellow on the Spread Ticket, and in red on Order Tickets and Quote Cubes (Jun)
- Users allowed to reset their own passwords (Sep)
- Ability to allocate Report Trades (Aug)

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
